In consideration of the acceptance of the foregoing entry, I hereby indemnify, release and hold harmless the California Rodeo, Inc. and the officers and members thereof and each of them, of and from all and every claim for damages which may accrue to me at any time hereafter, in favor of myself, my heirs, representatives of dependents, against said California Rodeo, Inc., its officers and members, or any of them, by reason of any injury, loss or damage which may be suffered by me or them or any of them because of any matter, thing or condition, negligence or default, whatsoever and I hereby assume and accept the risk and danger of any hurt, injury or damage which may occur through or by reason of any matter, thing, condition, negligence or default, or any person or persons whatsoever, in any aspect of my involvement with the California Rodeo, Inc. including exhibitions, sports, contests, and parades, or at the first aid station or any of them held or given by or under the direction of said California Rodeo, Inc. Any parent executing this release form on behalf of his child acknowledges the foregoing release on behalf of said child and further agrees to indemnify, release and hold harmless the California Rodeo, Inc., the officers and members thereof, and each of them, from any cost of expense, whatsoever, arising from any claim or demand for damages whether by way of litigation or otherwise.

Further, I hereby accept the conditions and the prize list of the California Rodeo, Inc and abide by the rules of the California Rodeo, Inc and such rules as are posted at the headquarters of the Rodeo, and I agree to perform through the contest of 2010.

Further, I hereby consent to the use by the California Rodeo, Inc its successors and assigns at any time or times of such photographs of myself as it or they may desire to use in newspapers, bulletins, booklets, manuals, and publications, newsreels and motion pictures and in such manner as it or they shall desire.

Track Event Information

CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Track entries close at 5:00 p.m., July 2, 2010. Entry fee must be received at the Rodeo office before close of entries. Receipt of personal check may constitute payment of entry at the sole discretion of the Rodeo. Entry forms may be obtained by writing to the California Rodeo, P.O. Box 1648, Salinas, CA 93902, visiting our website www.carodeo.com or calling 800-771-8807.

MORNING AND AFTERNOON PERFORMANCES: For information as to which events see the TRACK TIME SCHEDULE. In all events in which there are eliminations, the horses qualifying for further showing will be named by the judge immediately following the elimination showing. In the Stockhorse classes, the pattern performed in the FINALS may not follow that used in the elimination, but may be changed to suit the Judge and the Steward Committee.

SOUNDNESS OF HORSES: All horses used in competitive track events will be inspected for soundness and age at the discretion of, and by the California Rodeo Veterinarian or the Steward Committee of the California Rodeo. The Veterinarian or Committee may disqualify any horse upon the grounds of unsoundness or age, and the decision so made will be final.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Any exhibitor who withdraws from the Rodeo, or any event thereof, without sufficient cause therefore being accepted by the Steward Committee as reasonable, shall forfeit all entry fees, trophies and all previous winnings, and may be subject to such disciplinary measures as the Steward Committee shall impose.*

NON EXHIBITION OF ENTRIES: Horses must be shown in classes entered, this rule being subject to the exception and penalties stated in the paragraph above. All horses not in paddock when class or race is called by paddock officials may be disqualified.

RETURN OF ENTRY FEE: No entry fee shall be refunded unless a Veterinarian's Certificate is filed with acceptance by the Steward Committee prior to the scheduled exhibition certifying that failure to show, reason for withdrawing is caused accident, contagious or infectious disease or death of the horse to have been shown or there is filed with and accepted by the Steward Committee prior to the scheduled exhibition a letter by a doctor of medicine stating that he advises the patient not to perform for reason concerned with the patient's health.*

*Under no exception will the office fee or cattle charge be refundable.

CONTESTANTS' NUMBERS: Number must be obtained at least one (1) hour before a class event and **MUST BE WORN ON CONTESTANT'S BACK.**

EXHIBITION BY A MINOR: The guardian must sign a release on the entry form to qualify the contestant for appearance at the California Rodeo.

OFFICIALS: Paddock Announcer, Ross Stoneburg, Salinas, CA; Race official, Kelly Surbeck, Salinas, CA. All races governed by the rules of the Steward Committee of the California Rodeo.

All NRCHA classes will be judged under the rules of the National Reined Cow Horse Association except in conflict with the rules of California Rodeo Association. **All owners and riders must have current NRCHA membership.**

JUDGES' DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL IN ALL EVENTS.

STEWARDS COMMITTEE: The Steward Committee consists of the following: David Pedrazzi, Track Director; Doc Etienne, Braden Hoover, and Dr. Tim Eastman, Official Veterinarian.

Braden Hoover will flag all Track Events, except Barrel Race.
Tina Dairies will flag Barrel Race events.

FALSIFYING ENTRIES: Any person who shall place, or assent to false information on any entry blank, or who shall enter an event limited as to age or rider, to type or state of training of a horse, knowingly that the person or horse entered does not qualify for such class, may be disqualified by the Steward Committee of the Rodeo from showing in any event at the California Rodeo for a period not exceeding three (3) years and upon disqualification shall forfeit all entry fees, trophies and money won, paid or awarded in any event at the California Rodeo.

TRACK EVENTS

NOTE: In Track events, except WPRA Barrel Race, a fee of \$5.00 per horse must accompany entry to comply with State directions that such amount is to be collected to underwrite examining and laboratory tests to comply with State regulations.

RESERVED RIGHTS: The management reserves the right to make urine and/or saliva tests on all animals entered in class and to refuse, accept conditionally, and to cancel any entries, disqualifying exhibitors, prohibit exhibitions and cancel awards of prizes without claim for damages.

FINALS: In the Stockhorse classes the pattern performed in the finals may not follow that used in the eliminations, but may be changed to suit the judges and the Steward Committee.

In case of tie for 4th in the elimination, the cow work score will break the tie.

Class will run by NRCHA rules. Owners and Riders must be current NRCHA members. Contestants will do dry work and work one animal. No herd work. Four (4) high scoring horses will be in the finals during Saturday afternoon performance. No carry over of scores. Monies paid as per NRCHA schedule. Trophy buckle to First Place

TRACK EVENT NO. 3

OPEN STOCKHORSE CLASS

Purse: \$4,500.00

Entry Fee: \$325.00 (added)

Cattle & Office Fee: \$75.00

NRCHA Fee \$8.00

Contestants will do dry work and work one animal. No herd work. Four (4) high scoring horses will be in the finals during Sunday afternoon performance. No carry over of scores. Monies paid as per NRCHA schedule. Trophy buckle to First Place.

TRACK EVENT NO. 4

WPRA Barrel Race

Purse: \$22,500.00

Entry Fee: \$250.00 (added)

Timer: \$2.00

PROCOM Fee: \$14.00

This contest will be run by WPRA Barrel Race rules. This rodeo will accept both WPRA card and permit holders. All barrel and flag stands will be set up on the track in such manner as is possible under existing conditions. If entries are excessive, the number of runs during performance will be limited to the time allotted in the program. Excess entries will run slack. Check Rodeo office for time of slack. Trophy buckle to First Place.
