OF THE FIRST THREE TEAMS THAT PLACE IN THE DAILY EVENT EACH TEAM MEMBER WILL RECEIVE CALIFORNIA RODEO LOGO ITEMS:

- 1ST PLACE- 2010 LOGO BELT BUCKLES
- 2ND PLACE- HOODED SWEATSHIRTS
- 3RD PLACE- BALL CAPS

THESE ITEMS CAN BE EXCHANGED FOR SIZING AND/OR ANY ITEM OF EQUAL VALUE.

ON SUNDAY THE FIRST PLACE TEAM MEMBERS WILL EACH RECEIVE A GOLD AND SILVER CHAMPIONSHIP BELT BUCKLE. SECOND AND THIRD WILL RECEIVE PLACE RIBBONS.

Calf Dressing Contest Rules

A. ELIGIBILITY

1. Contestants will come from local companies.
2. Contestants will be selected by each company to represent that company.
3. All company personnel are eligible to participate.
4. All contestants must complete the Entry/Release form.
5. All contestants must wear long-sleeve shirts and blue jeans. Baseball caps and headbands are not allowed during the event.
6. Contestants can enter the event only once, for only one team and can not be a substitute on another team for any reason.

B. THE TEAM

1. Each team will consist of three contestants
2. A maximum of 12 teams per day will participate on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.
3. First, Second, and Third place winners from Thursday, Friday, and Saturday will advance to the Finals on Sunday.
4. Team members in Sunday's Finals must be the same contestants who participated in the preliminaries.
No exceptions! Injury substitutions are not allowed. A team may participate in the finals with less than three members.

C. DRESSING PROCEDURES

1. At least nine calves will be furnished each day.
2. Each team will have its own judge and will start against the fence closest to the main grandstands.
3. Calves will be turned loose on the track and will have 4 to 6 foot lead ropes attached to halters.
4. When the starting gun is fired the teams will attempt to catch a calf. Bulldogging, pulling the tail and any other unnecessary roughness will not be allowed. Knocking down the calf is allowed.
5. Once a calf is caught by a team, it cannot be taken away by another team. Judges decisions are final.
6. After the calf is caught, one team member must hold the lead rope and may not hold the halter or touch the calf. This team member is not allowed to assist other team members in dressing the calf.
7. The two other team members must dress the calf with a pair of blue jeans. Both hind legs must go through the jean pant legs. One calf leg in each jean leg. The jeans must be pulled all the way up over the tail and the suspenders pulled over the head in front of the ears.
8. When the calf is standing and properly dressed, the team's judge will give the OK for one team member to run to the Head Judge and call out the team's name.
9. Each team is responsible for removing the blue jeans from the calf and returning them to their judge. Failure to remove the blue jeans from the calf may result in disqualification of that team.
10. Any judge can disqualify any team if the judge sees that any rules are being broken. Judges' decisions are final.
11. If any team member is intoxicated prior to the event, the entire team will be disqualified.
12. After the contest has ended, only the three winning teams are to remain in front of the grandstands for presentation of the awards. All other teams are to promptly leave the area.
