- If it is your intention to join the Association, you must first serve on the Manpower Committee as a volunteer for (70) seventy hours on any Rodeo Association event. During that time, you will be evaluated on your performance of your Committee assignment(s). Once you have fulfilled these requirements, you may be considered for membership openings. To be considered for any of these membership openings, your Committee evaluations will be scrutinized very closely. Please keep this in mind during your time as a volunteer.
- Submit your application to the Rodeo Office, **along with a photocopy of your Driver's License or photo ID**. Applications submitted without the photocopy will not be accepted.
- Any application submitted after July 10, 2010 will be held on file until the 2011 rodeo, unless your name has been submitted by a Director or Chairman for a specific committee.

As consideration for being allowed to volunteer as a committee person in the California Rodeo the undersigned acknowledges that committee activities involve animals, crowds and other factors which can at times be dangerous and unpredictable and that injuries can occur for a variety of reasons. The undersigned expressly acknowledges that his/her participation as a committee volunteer may involve such hazard.

In consideration of permission by the California Rodeo to allow the undersigned to be a committee person, the undersigned hereby releases, indemnifies and holds the California Rodeo, Inc., all of the Rodeo's officers, directors, sponsors, employees, the City of Salinas, agents or affiliates free and harmless from any claim, expense, liability or demand of any kind or nature arising from or in any way connected with the participation of the undersigned as a committee person in the California Rodeo.

California Rodeo Volunteer Policy

1. Must be 12 years of age to volunteer and or be a Junior Committee person.
2. Must be 16 years of age to become a California Rodeo Committee person.
3. Must be 21 years of age to work where alcohol is served or on security.
4. Must volunteer on Manpower Committee for 70 hours at any California Rodeo event before being considered becoming a Committee person.
5. No benefits such as tickets, shirts or Committee ID badges until placed on a Committee after serving Manpower hours.
6. Not automatically put on committee after time on Manpower. There must be an opening and acceptance by Chairperson.
7. Time for 5 year badge does not start until place on a permanent committee.
